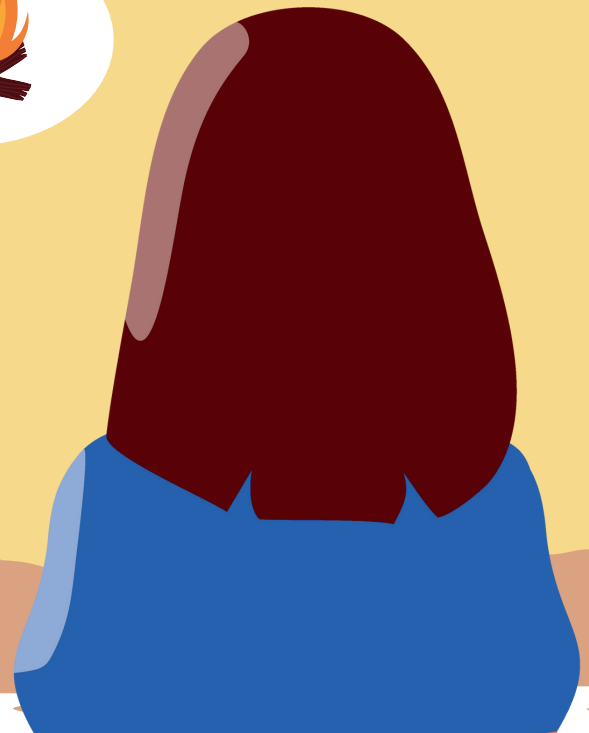


Meha immediately felt very sorry for what she had done.

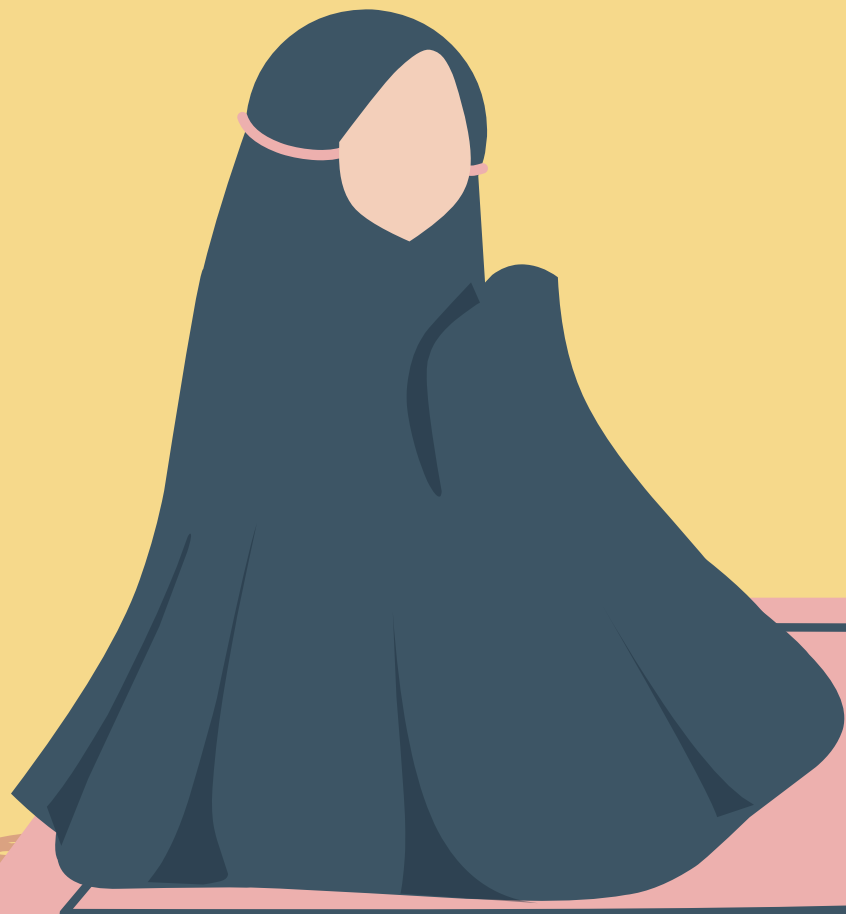




“Meḥa, Allah is

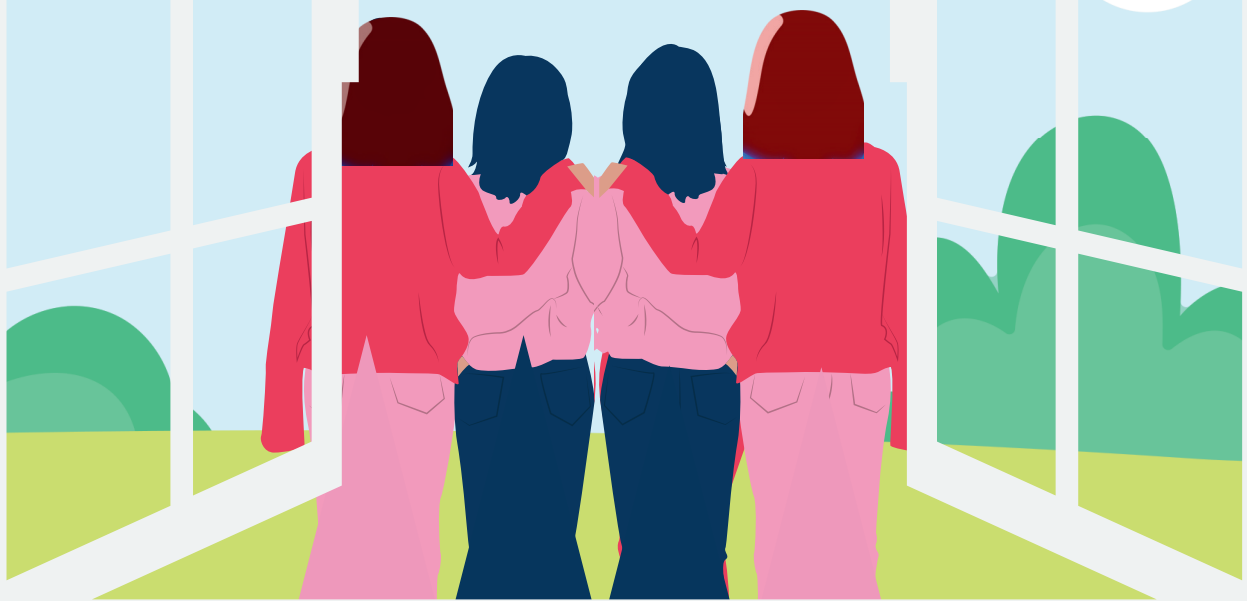
She came to school and Meha apologized to her sincerely. “Oh and before I forget!” said Meha, handing Layla her present and a small bottle of Zamzam water with medicine.
