in need.

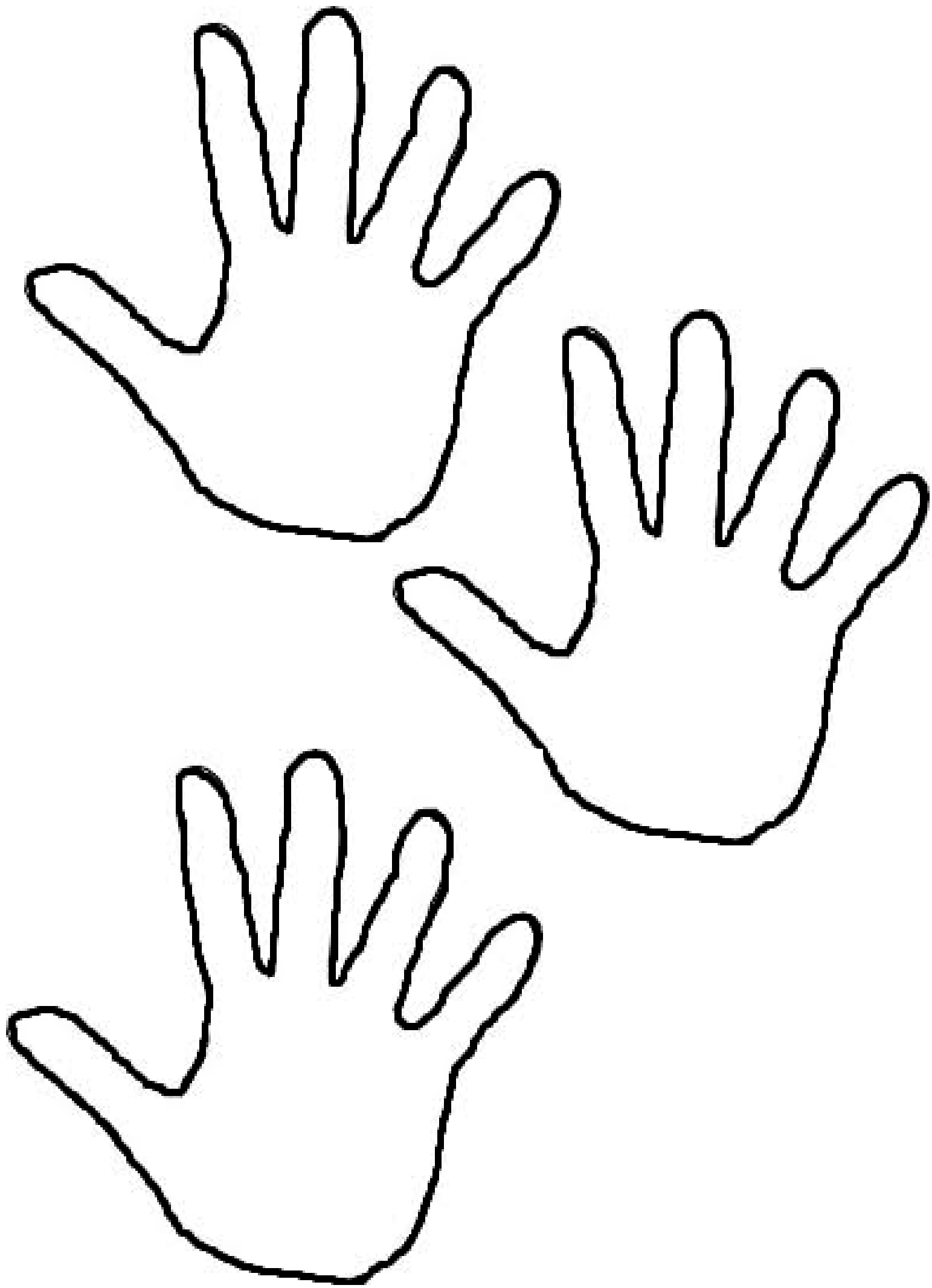


Learn and teach
